

**SUBJECT: CONTINUED MORATORIUM ON APPLICATIONS FOR NEW MOTOR
VEHICLE FILLING STATIONS**

DATE: SEPTEMBER 15, 2006

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by the 1963 Michigan Constitution and the 1997 Detroit City Charter, I, Kwame M. Kilpatrick, Mayor of the City of Detroit, issue this executive order. Because the circumstances that are addressed in Executive Order 2004-2 remain, the City of Detroit requires additional time to improve the process for the establishment of new motor vehicle filling stations, to provide safeguards to lessen the potential negative impact of new motor vehicle filling stations, and to assist established motor vehicle filling stations in maintaining compliance, or in achieving compliance, with applicable state law, City ordinances, rules and regulations, building permits, and zoning grant conditions. Therefore, Executive Order No. 2004-2 is extended and shall expire on September 15, 2008, unless extended, modified or terminated by further order.

This executive order is effective this date.
