As part of the community benefits ordinance process the City of Detroit invites you to attend the kickoff meeting for the Hudson's Site. General selection of candidates for the Neighborhood Advisory Council (NAC) will occur at the second meeting, held Monday, September 25, 2017.

Bedrock LLC is reaching out to the community to receive input on the redevelopment of the site of the former J.L. Hudson's Department Store, a two-acre site in the heart of downtown Detroit bounded by Woodward Avenue, Gratiot Avenue, Grand River Avenue, and Farmer Street. The mixeduse project will include over one million gross square feet of space, including commercial office, retail, residential, public space, and parking. This transformational development is expected to be a destination for residents and visitors alike, creating thousands of jobs and providing a unique experience that can't be found elsewhere in the region.

Construction is anticipated to begin in December of 2017.
