The meeting convened at 12:10 p.m. Supervising Electrical Inspector, Mr. Durand Capers and Mr. Phil Clark were also present at the meeting. The meeting took place at *Traffic Jam* Restaurant.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

Mr. Litt made a motion to approve the agenda. Motion Carried.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Litt to approve the minutes of November 19, 2015 as amended. **Motion Carried.**

BOARD CONSIDERATIONS:

Mr. Terence Coleman: Mr. Coleman came down to renew his Journeyman License on 12/16/2015, Ms. Swint asked whether he had heard from Jonathon Ellison regarding the letter he was asked to submit documenting Mr. Coleman's hours in order to sit for the Master's examination. Mr. Coleman stated that he has not heard from Mr. Ellison, nor does he expect Mr. Ellison to submit the letter. The issue was presented to the Board at December's meeting.

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BOARD CONSIDERATIONS (CONT.):

Mr. Litt asked if Mr. Ellison's company was affiliated with Local 58, and Mr. Preuss stated Mr. Ellison was previously, but at the time in question he was not, but overtures have been made to Mr. Ellison. Mr. Litt asked Mr. Preuss if he would contact Mr. Ellison.

After further discussion, Mr. Brown made a motion that Mr. Coleman be informed that the Board will accept alternate means of documentation for consideration in order to sit for the Master's exam (i.e. paycheck stubs, W2s). Mr. Capers made a call to Mr. Ellison during the meeting, and informed the Board that Mr. Ellison stated he and Mr. Coleman have strengthened their tenuous relationship, and he will submit a letter of documentation to the Board. The Board will still follow through with contacting Mr. Coleman.

Mr. David Vance: Mr. Vance had a hearing last month in which the Board denied his request to sit for the Journeyman exam. Mr. Vance has subsequently submitted a letter to appeal the Board's decision. Mr. McAlister has spoken further with Mr. Dean Austin of the State of Michigan Electrical Division, and Mr. Austin was very emphatic that MDOT work requires licensing for electricians who do work on their behalf.

Mr. Preuss stated under the City of Detroit's *Ordinance 604-H*, the Board has to approve the Apprenticeship program. Just because someone has a bona fide Apprenticeship program does not mean it is approved by the Board or the State of Michigan. Mr. Preuss suggested the Board request from Local 17 that the Board visit Local 17 and see their local apprenticeship program firsthand. Mr. Litt stated he would endorse this suggestion as a motion of action.

Mr. Clark stated for a person to have an electrical apprenticeship program there are required course contents for a total of 476 hours and from the contents, it is very easy to see if it is code related. This documentation can be accessed from the Department of Labor as a means of public record. Mr. Brown made a motion that the Board obtain the abovementioned documents from Local 17 before the Board moves forward in making a determination. **Motion Carried.**
