#### <u>UNFINISHED BUSINESS</u>

- 2015 Michigan Residential Code-Arc Fault Letter: A draft letter was presented to the Board for review. After review, Glenn Davis stated he would like to amend a sentence and will email the Board his edit for approval. The letter will also be revised to reflect the new Chief of the Bureau of Construction Codes, Mr. Keith Lambert.
- **Board's By-Laws**: It has been some time since the Board has revisited this issue. After discussion, the Board proposed an extended meeting in August at DTE Energy.
- **George Vidas & Sign Specialist Exam:** Mr. Vidas was sent a letter explaining the necessary documentation and proof of completion of the required Sign Specialist class in order to sit for the Sign Specialist exam. Mr. McAlister spoke with Mr. Austen, Chief, State of Michigan Electrical Division, regarding the State of Michigan's Sign Specialist exam format. There are 30 questions with a one-hour time limit. The exam covers the *National Electrical Code Article 600 Chapter 3-Wiring Methods* and the *Michigan Part 8 Rules*.
- Ordinance 604-H Modifications: Glenn Davis summarized to the Board, David Bell's (BSEED Director) recommendations in regard to the Board's makeup which will go before the codification board today, then City Council.
