UNFINISHED BUSINESS

• 2015 Michigan Residential Code-Arc Fault Letter: Ms. Swint spoke with Mr. Phil Clark, who serves on several Code panels, to ask whom the letter should be addressed. Mr. Clark stated the letter should be addressed to Mr. Irvin Poke, Chief of the State of Michigan's Bureau of Construction Codes. Mr. Poke is responsible for creating the ad-hoc panel that reviews changes to the Michigan Residential Code. Ms. Swint will have a draft letter for the Board to review at the June meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

• Mr. Cooley sits on the pro-temp committee for the Michigan Chapter of the IAEI (International Association of Electrical Inspectors) and has received information from the IAEI secretary, Mr. David Williams, regarding mechanisms occurring at the state that will negatively change the direction of electrical licensure and installations. Mr. Williams wrote a letter to the State expressing his thoughts regarding these proposed changes, and the State's response was not receptive. In their response they stated electricians were minimally trained, and feel a license should not be required to install electrical wiring, just to energize it.
