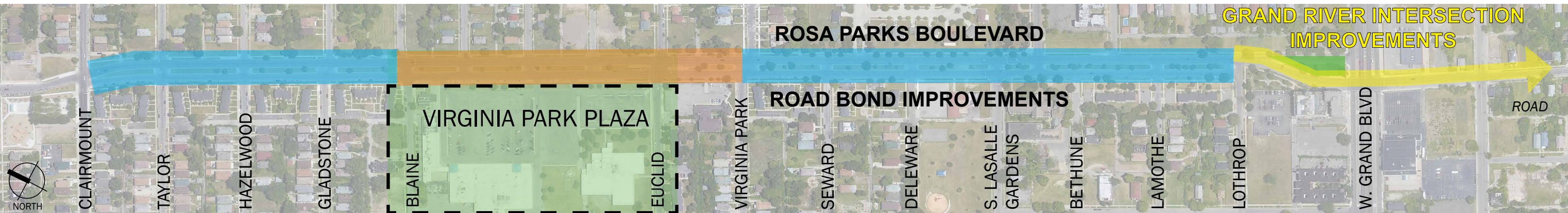

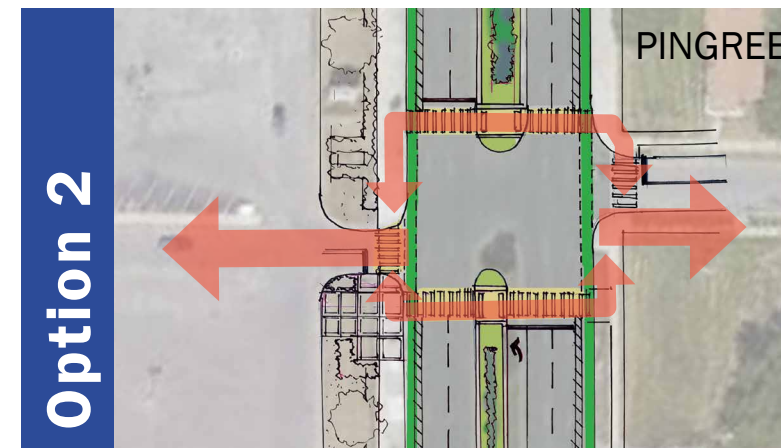
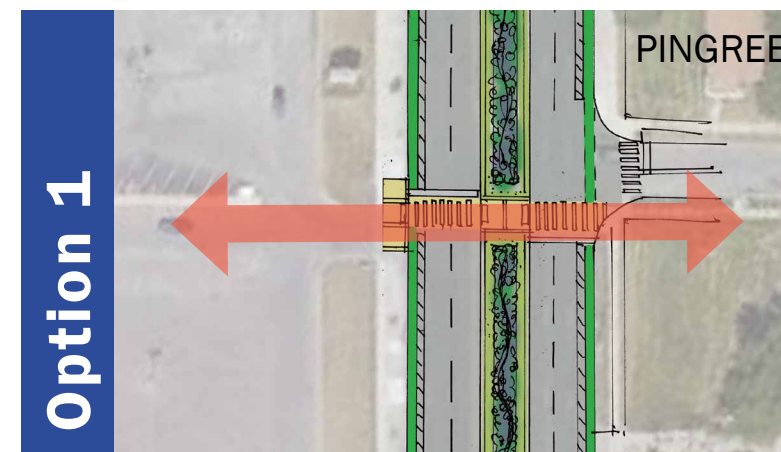

How would you like to see historic “12th Street” expressed in planting, signage or other features?

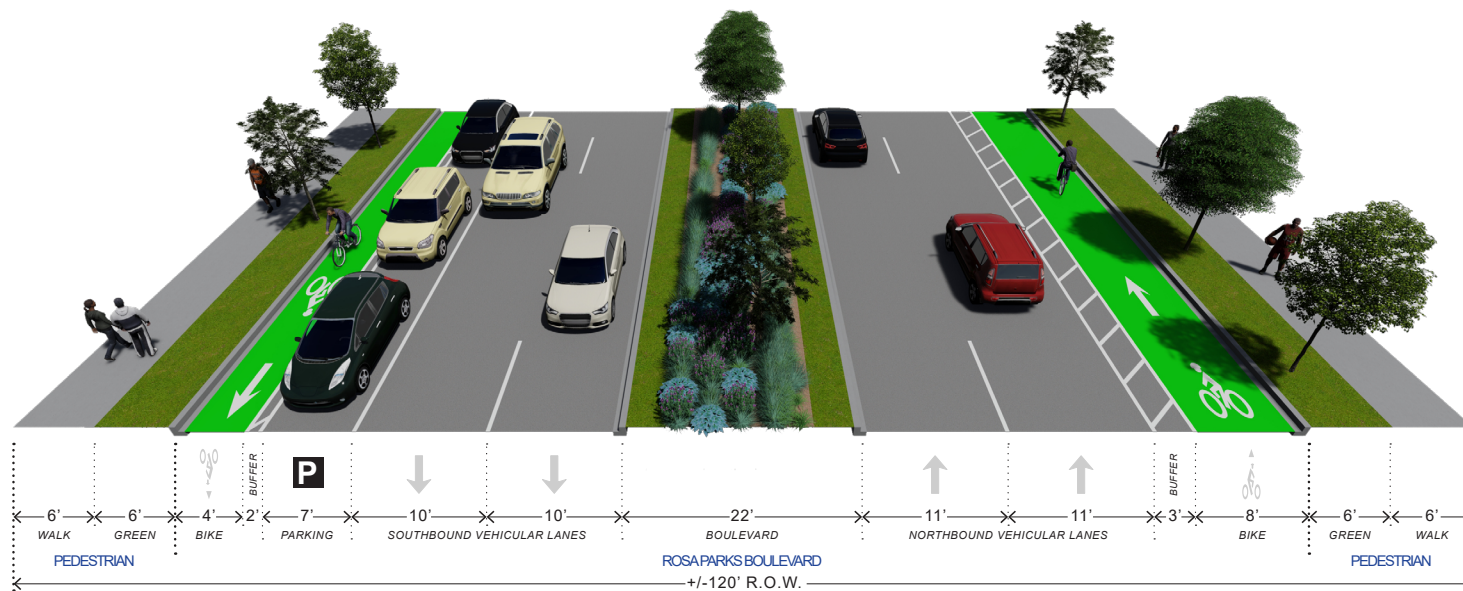
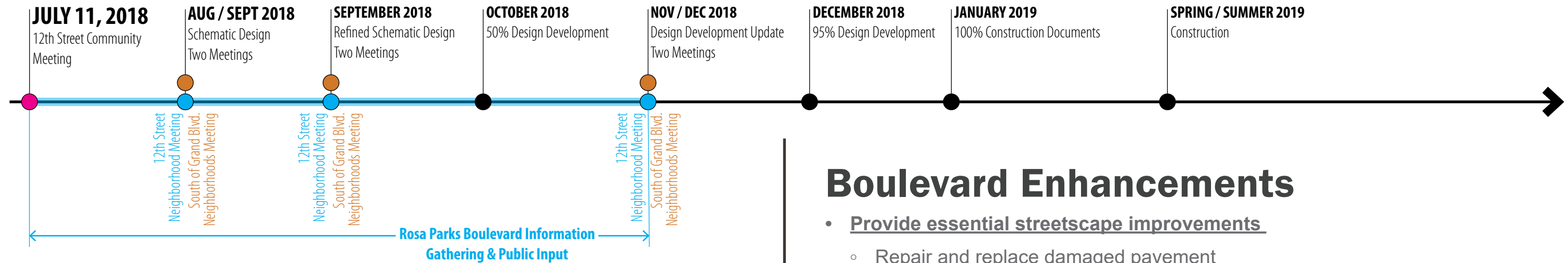

Boulevard Enhancements

- Provide essential streetscape improvements
 - Repair and replace damaged pavement
 - Sidewalk ADA Ramps
- Enhance neighborhood identity and character
 - Median Plantings
 - 12th Street banners and honor heritage through branding
- Site Furnishings and Amenities
 - Benches
 - Bike Racks
 - Trash Receptacles

Improve Mobility

- Provide SAFE and ACCESSIBLE public roadways and sidewalks
 - Pavement Markings to define roadway use
 - Enhanced Crosswalks
- Develop COMPLETE streets accommodating pedestrians, bikes, public transportations and cars
 - Provide critical connections to businesses, recreation and jobs
 - Protected and Buffered Bike Lanes
 - Defined on-street parking zones
