

Magnitude of FCA's Proposed Assembly Plant

FCA is proposing to build a new auto assembly plant immediately north of the existing Jefferson North Assembly Plant, with 4,950 new jobs and \$2.5 billion (1.6B for Mack and 900M for JNAP) in new investment.

Assembly plants require supplier plants that produce 5-7 times the number of jobs as those at the main plant.
