- 3. Improve safety to reduce pedestrian and bicycle crashes




Key Considerations:

- Adjacent Residential Area






Current Streetscape along Dexter Avenue










Traffic Calming Improvements













- Davison Avenue
 - Hawk signal and infrastructure improvements needed by MDOT

- Broadstreet Avenue
 - Forced right turn infrastructure improvements needed by MDOT

- Waverly Street
 - speed cushions, chicanes needed to decrease speed
