- Wall design would be approved by acutely impacted residents along Beniteau Street
- Aesthetics of wall to be determined at the completion of Sound study (mid-May)
- FCA to provide support on wall aesthetics

FCA proposes landscaping improvements around plant and retention pond

- Natural sustainable landscaping and vegetation
- Low-impact grass, plantings and trees
 - Natural bio-swales and rain gardens






Road Improvements
