Over the past two months, City Planning and Department of Neighborhoods staff as well as team members from the Perkins+Will consulting team have been actively meeting around the community to discuss the project and solicit ideas. The first series of larger, focused workshops have been scheduled and will occur on September 11th and 12th, both beginning at 5:30pm. 
