7 elements of proposed State Fair agreement

- 1) City sells 142 Acres to Hillwood/Sterling Group for appraised price of \$9 million.
- 2) No tax breaks or incentives for project.
- 3) Amazon distribution center opens in 2022, occupying 78 acres:


\$400 million investment3.8 million square feetMinimum 1,200 jobs

- 4) Hillwood/Sterling pays for \$7 million transit center on site to handle 9 routes serving 30,000 riders a week.
- 5) No traffic on State Fair Street. All traffic onto 8 Mile or Woodward.
- 6) Detroit at Work partners with Amazon for placing Detroiters in jobs and qualifying Detroiters as entrepreneurs for Amazon's delivery service.
- 7) Hillwood/Sterling will develop two other large parcels with other companies goal is 2,000 jobs on site when all built out.




