NIP Overview

- Detroit voters approved Proposal N for Neighborhoods, a \$250M comprehensive plan to address vacant houses in Detroit through rehabilitation or demolition.
 - Goal: to preserve 6,000 homes and demolish 8,000 blighted homes.
- The City plans to begin submitting demolition contracts and rehabs in January.
- The Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP) is conducting fair, efficient procurement that promotes use of Detroit based businesses and Detroit workers in line with City ordinance and executive orders.
- The City has developed processes to spend and document bond proceeds to ensure tax compliance.




Bond Rehab - First Release (300)







Proposal N


On the November 3rd ballot, Detroit residents approved Proposal N for Neighborhoods, a comprehensive plan to address 16,000 vacant houses in Detroit through rehabilitation or demolition. Proposal N allows the City of Detroit to sell \$250 million in Neighborhood Improvement Bonds.

WHAT YOU MAY SEE

- Asbestos tape and signs
- Dumpsters
- Trucks and trailers
- Workers in protective suits and masks





CONTRACTOR DO's & DON'T'S

- Contractors may NOT use surrounding properties to perform the abatement unless they ask for permission;
- Contractors may park vehicles, equipment, or dumpsters in the street or alley as long as they allow safe passage;
- Contractors may NOT park dumpsters in front of an occupied house. Contractors
 will often park dumpsters either in the driveway of a house or in the street in front
 of a house;
- Contractors may NOT stockpile house debris in the <u>front yard</u>.
- Contractors may remove boards from houses prior to abatement.





DEMOLITIONS W/ ASBESTOS

Some demolitions have asbestos still inside the house due to unsafe conditions. We call these "partial ordered" demolitions.

You will see many of the same requirements:

- Asbestos tape and signs
- Workers in protective suits and masks
