Issues and Questions

- 1. What is the status of decommissioning and the continuing sale of the department's assets? Last year it was reported that the decommissioning should be completed by this June 30. Is this still the correct timeline? Please explain what EDSA stands for.
- 2. In the Plan of Adjustment, the PLD revenues for 2017 through 2023 total almost \$100 M for sale of assets. What is the projected revenue collection in the proposed budget? What have been the actual collections year to date?
- 3. What progress has been made to ready the Mistersky site for disposition. Has there been interest in the property?
- 4. What plans are being made to ready the substations that will no longer needed by DTE for disposition? Is the \$250,000 contract in place to clean up 31 substations a sufficient amount to complete the project, by this December 31 as previously stated? Please explain in depth.
- 5. What equipment rentals are taking place that project revenue of \$467,000? How much is projected to be earned in the current fiscal year?
- 6. Please explain the projected revenue budget in other reimbursements of \$933,000. Where are the funds coming from and why is this dropping from current year?
- 7. Please explain the projected revenue budget in sale of miscellaneous supplies of \$318,240. Where are the funds coming from and why is this dropping from current year?
- 8. Please explain the current staffing at PLD. How many full time positions and how many contractors? Are there any unfilled positions?

PUBLIC LIGHTING (38)

AGENCY PLAN

MISSION:

The Public Lighting Department (PLD) supports the Public Lighting Authority (PLA) as it maintains the upgraded street light system. PLD works with TMC Alliance and DTE Energy to assure the safety of the general public and to provide reliable power to customers through the City's distribution system as the City assists with converting customers to DTE's system.


On February 5, 2013, the City created the PLA, a separate municipal corporation pursuant to Michigan Public Act 392 of 2012 (as amended) and the Municipal Lighting Authority Act, MCL 123.1261, to manage and maintain the City's public lighting system. Pursuant to an amendment to the City Utility Users' Tax Act, 1990 PA 100 (as amended) MCL 141.1151-MCL141.1177, the PLA utilizes \$12.5M in utility user tax proceeds to satisfy the debt service obligation of bonds issued to modernize the street light system. Through an inter-local agreement, the City provides additional funds to the PLA to finance the operations and maintenance of the street lighting system after the capital project is complete.

On July 1, 2014, the City entered into an agreement with DTE Energy to transition electric customers to DTE Energy. The conversion will be accomplished over a 5 to 7-year period. During this time, the City, through its contractor, will operate and maintain an electric grid with DTE reimbursing the City and its contractor for all expenses related to the delivery of electric power. This agreement excludes decommissioning, abatement and salvage operations. PLD currently coordinates these activities in line with the transition of customers.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

- Maintain electricity distribution grid during the transition to DTE Energy, as the City of Detroit phases out of the electric service business.
- Maintain legacy electric conduit grid and make available to City of Detroit information technology department for fiber optic communication cables and lease excess capacity to private fiber optic companies.
