ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

The Joe Louis Greenway is a proposed 27.5-mile pathway for walkers, joggers, and cyclists. The Framework Plan finalized the route of the greenway, which was largely based on feedback from residents at 57 public meetings, the first phase of the construction is from Warren Avenue to Fullerton Avenue, approximately 3 miles, would start construction of phase 1 costs \$30 Million and includes environmental remediation, new parks, community hub and security cameral network, walking and running paths, bike lanes, stormwater infrastructure, and street furniture.

A common theme from residents at the public meetings was safety of the greenway. The Detroit Riverfront Conservancy, Detroit Police Department, and Integral Blue were consulted for camera models and locations. Installation of the camera surveillance technology is estimated at 1.43 Million:

Installation of bike lanes will cost approximately \$1.40 Million. Approximately 93% of the proposed bike lanes will be off street.

- Connects Dearborn, Hamtramck, Highland Park, and five council districts



Renovation will help stimulate development on Grand River.









