A slow street is a residential street with some form of traffic calming, such as speed cushions and signage.






Progress on creating 'slow streets'

In an effort to make Detroit's residential streets safer the City of Detroit will have installed over 6,000 speed cushions by the end of 2021.



What is a 'slow street network'?

The City wants to go a step further and connect these slower. residential streets to create a network of safe streets for walking, biking, and getting around your neighborhood. These will connect residents to parks, schools, rec. centers, shops, and more.



Lots of cities have created slow streets networks










Draft Slow Street Network
