For more than 35 years, Development Centers' services have focused on helping adults and children in and around Detroit improve their lives. Today, our three primary focus areas are mental health, workforce development and early childhood education.

When it comes to mental health and well-being, Development Centers believes that all people deserve access to affordable, and comprehensive health care. In June of 2021, Development Centers became an official Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic.



What is the Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) model?

Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics are specifically designed to provide the community with an all-inclusive range of substance use and mental health disorder services, especially for individuals who have the most complex needs.

CCBHC services include:

- 24/7 crisis mental health services
- Same day & next day appointments for mental & physical health services for children & adults
- Streamlined physical & behavior health services for the uninsured, underinsured, veterans, and LGBTQ populations
- Access to prescriptions, treatment and recovery without financial barriers
- Outpatient mental health, psychiatric & substance use services with licensed counselors
- Care coordination for specialized services
- Targeted case management

Who is Served by CCBHCs?



This new model of services increases mental and physical health access to historically underserved populations. Services at Development Centers are available to any individual in need of care including children ages six to 17 years old and adults 18 years or older regardless of one's ability to pay.

Michigan Mental Health Statistics



According to the National Alliance of Mental Illness- Many Michiganders struggle to get the help they need with 37% of adults in Michigan suffer from symptoms of anxiety or depression.

27% say that they were unable to access services such as counseling or therapy to help them.

In Michigan 355,000 adults have a serious mental illness.

119,000 Michiganders suffer from depression.

An inadequate mental health system affects individuals, families and communities.

More Facts

57.8% of Michiganders ages 12-17 do not receive care for mental illness.

1,548 lives were lost to suicide last year.

On average 1 person in the United States dies by suicide every eleven minutes.

2 in 5 adults that are incarcerated have a history of mental illness

1 in 7 youth in the juvenile justice system has a mental illness condition

Among 16 Metropolitan areas in the state; Detroit has the highest percentage of residents with untreated mental illness at 48%

Based on the provided statistics, it is evident that more than ever the services at The Development Centers CCBH Care are desperately needed.

Governor Gretchen Whitmer recognizes the need for additional mental health services and has recently proposed a push for more availability for mental health services for residents of Detroit, as well as the entire state of Michigan.
