What led us to this project

- Gap in Indoor rec access in the Cody Rouge neighborhood:
 - Neighborhood with high youth and senior population
 - Largest gap in rec center access in the City currently
- Residents have asked for a rec center in Rouge Park for many years

- Stakeholders have advocated for expanding the use of Brennan Pool facility, the only outdoor public pool in the City
- Tom Gores' Family Foundation & Detroit Pistons have committed \$20 million to build this new community center in Rouge Park!

Partner with the community on programs


Currently **59.6%** of Detroiters have rec center access within 1.5 miles

- provide indoor rec access for over 24,000 additional residents










