Message from CKG Management Office

- Residents can request new carpet after 7 years of residency and paint after 5 years.
- Resident must pass a housekeeping inspection to receive new carpet/paint.
- The housekeeping inspection is scheduled at least 7 days after the request is made. If the inspection is failed, residents have 3 days after the initial inspection to request reinspection.

Annual enrollment period is from October 15th - December 7th Here are some ideas to help you:

- Shop the market to see what new benefits might be available
- Check if the benefits you have are the best fit for you
- Be aware of scamming
- Take your time to compare new plans to your existing one
- Consult with an agent who can help you break down the differences and the benefits of moving/changing plans
- DO NOT answer unsolicited calls or call the numbers on the ads that you see on TV
- Be cautious with your private information, like your Social Security number or your Medicare ID.

HAP, Choice grant partner, can connect you with a trusted agent to help you evaluate your current plan, discuss what options you have, or changes (if any). September 22nd Resident Council Meeting Highlights





The Clement Kern Gardens September Tenant Council Meeting kicked off with Kimberly Cooley, a CNI Career Coach with Detroit at Work, introducing career coaching and details on how to enroll in the program. Shelby Howard of the Planning and Developing Department at the City of Detroit spoke next about new amenities coming to the neighborhood such as the Owen's Recreational Center and the Southwest Greenway projects. Shelby wants to partner with CKG residents and UCHC to brainstorm neighborhood events ideas. Kevin Schronce narrated a video of the Choice Neighborhood Initiative's development plan that gave residents a view of what the project is proposing. Residents had many design related questions that at this stage are still being worked out. Concerns about accessibility were raised and Rebecca Labov of the Housing and Revitalization Depart assured all residents that accessible units would be available at every stage of the project. Claudia Sanford ended the meeting with a discussion with tenants about UCHC's new Event **Committee and Resident Voice Committee. Residents are** encouraged to reach out to UCHC staff if they would like to get involved with one of the committees.
