- Shop the market to see what new benefits might be available
- · Check if the benefits you have are the best fit for you

- Consult with an agent who can help you break down the differences and the benefits of moving/changing plans
- DO NOT answer unsolicited calls or call the numbers on the adds that you see on TV
- Be cautious with your private information, like your Social Security or your Medicare ID.














Housing Phases by Location:

Phase I: Left Field

2610 Cochrane St, the Southeast corner of Cochrane and Fisher Service Drive. Directly North of the former Tigers Stadium

Phase IIA: Preserve on Ash I & II

Several blocks along 14th and Ash St, just South of Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd

Phase IIB: North Corktown Preserve Estates Home Ownership

Directly East of Preserve on Ash I &II, West of Wabash St along Ash St.

Phase III: Clement Kern Gardens

Located on Bagley St, between Rosa Parks Blvd and Trumbull Ave

Phase IV: The Bridge

Between Rosa Parks Blvd and Cochrane St, directly West of Left Field

Phase V: Bagley Homeownership

Northwest corner of Bagley St and Wabash St, about two blocks West of Clement Kern Gardens
