

#### **Project Background**


- The City of Detroit Parks & Rec recently received \$240,000 for improvements at Stoudamire Park from the Community Foundation of Southeast Michigan's "Pistons Palace" Funds.
- We are conducting community engagement to hear what amenities would best serve the families and residents that use the park.
- We will continue to fund raise for a "phase 2" of improvements as well.
- After community engagement the project will be finalized for construction from late 2023 into 2024.



## Park Renaming

After a re-naming campaign and petition, Troester-Hayes park was renamed in honor of Marlowe Stoudamire, a community leader who grew up a few blocks from the park, who worked and advocated for increased opportunities and improved quality of life for Detroiters. During the process there was an outflow of support from the area and across the City, the petition received the required signatures in record time.
