
### **Construction Update - Water Upgrades**

  - Warwick St. (McNichols Rd. to Florence St.)

  - Edinborough Rd. (McNichols Rd. to Bretton Dr.)

#### **Construction Update – Street and Lawn Restoration**



 Permanent street and lawn restoration will begin in the spring



- Permanent restoration is generally completed between April and October. This is the optimal time to place asphalt and restore grass.
- As a temporary measure, crushed aggregate was placed on streets under construction to allow residents access to the road.



 DWSD and contractors are monitoring those streets daily to assess the condition of the aggregate.

# **Construction Update - Sewer Upgrades**

Sewer upgrades began in mid-January and are planned in phases.

#### PHASE 1

- Verne Ave.
  - Between Shaftsbury Ave. & Sunderland Rd.
  - Between Westmoreland Rd. & Huntington Rd.
  - Between Outer Dr. & Shaftsbury Ave.
- Grand River Ave.
  - Between Outer Dr. & Warwick St.
  - Between Avon Ave. & Glastonbury Rd.
  - Between Outer Dr. & Bretton
  - Between Bretton & Outer Dr.
  - Between Warwick St. & Avon Ave.
- Ashton Ave. Between Puritan Ave. & Pilgrim St.
- Water & Sewerage Department

- Intersection of Outer Dr. & Shaftsbury Ave.
- Florence St. Between Evergreen Rd. & Plainview Ave.
- Scarsdale St. Between Avon Ave. & Glastonbury Rd.
- Southfield Fwy.
  - Between Florence St. & Verne Ave.
  - Between McNichols Rd. & Grove St.
  - Between Pilgrim St. & Puritan Ave.
- Plainview Ave.
  - Between Verne Ave. & Grove St.
  - Between Florence St. & Verne
- Bretton
  - Between Westmoreland Rd. & Edinborough Rd.
  - Between Huntington Rd. & Outer Dr.

# **Construction Update - Sewer Upgrades (Cont'd.)**

#### PHASE 2

- Intersection of Puritan Ave. & Florence St.
- South of Grove St. Between Evergreen Rd. & Plainview Ave.
- North of Grove St. Between Westmoreland Rd. & Edinborough Rd.
- Between Ashton Rd. & Rosemont Ave. From Midland St. to Pilgrim St.
- Between Plainview Ave. & Westmoreland Rd.
  - From McNichols Rd. to Grove St.
  - From Verne Ave. to Grove St.
- Between Huntington Rd. & Outer Dr. From McNichols Rd. to Grove St.

- Between Shaftsbury Ave. & Warwick St. From Verne Ave. to Grove St.
- Between Glastonbury Ave. & Rosemont Ave.
  - From Grove St. to Verne Ave.
  - From Pilgrim St. to Puritan Ave.
- Between Outer Dr. & Shaftsbury Ave.
  - From Florence St. to Verne Ave.
- Between Edinborough Rd. & Huntington Rd.
  - From Florence St. to Verne Ave.
- South of Evergreen Rd.
  - From Florence St. to Verne Ave.

#### **Overview of Easement Access**



- DWSD needs access to manholes for repairs.
  - Objects blocking manholes will be removed including fencing, vegetation, and other structures.
  - Contractors will be inspecting the area and marking utilities.
     Access to backyards may be necessary.
  - You will be notified if the easement near your home is obstructed.
  - Photos will be taken prior to removal.
- Contractors will have large trucks and heavy equipment in the area.
  - For the safety of everyone in the neighborhood, please keep a safe distance from all machinery and work areas.
  - Please secure all pets.
- Contractors are required to wear a mask and maintain the recommended six-foot distance.



#### WHERE'S YOUR LINE?

Most of the city's sewer pipes are located in the rear of the property; a few are located in the street. Sewers are typically in the alley or the city easement in your backyard.

#### WHO WILL FIX IT?

Property owners are responsible for the sewer service from the point at which it leaves the house (beneath the basement) and connects to the city sewer.


\*In some neighborhoods the property owner is responsible for the alley.
