ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

After an 18-month process, the City's Parks Planning team is excited to share a draft of the Parks & Recreation Strategic Plan for public review. The plan represents the vision for Detroit Parks and Recreation for the next ten years, and is shaped by extensive outreach completed in 2020 and 2021, including over 700 surveys responses, 27 focus groups. GSD is collecting feedback through an online feedback form, virtual meetings and a series of open house events. The draft plan is available for public comment until June 30, 2022.

Note: Funding for the plan and survey are being done in-house with existing GSD staff without any designated funding being allocated or spent.
